## Registration Information

## Attractions

- ♦ Schools may choose up to six attractions (listed on page 7).
- ♦ The fee for each attraction is per person.

## Lodging

- ♦ Schools will choose their lodging subject to availability.
- ♦ No more than 4 people should be assigned per room. The lodging fee is \$50 per room, whether there are 1 or 4 people in the room.
- ♦ It is imperative that we have your final room count prior to your arrival.
- ♦ Check-in and check-out times vary by lodging property. Please contact your assigned property once you have received your confirmation letter.

- ♦ The meal prices are as follows:
