Registration Information

Attractions

- Schools may choose up to six attractions (listed on page 7).
- The fee for each attraction is per person.

Lodging

- Schools will choose their lodging subject to availability.
- No more than 4 people should be assigned per room. The lodging fee is \$50 per room, whether there are 1 or 4 people in the room.
- It is imperative that we have your final room count prior to your arrival.
- Check-in and check-out times vary by lodging property. Please contact your assigned property once you have received your confirmation letter.

Meals

- The meal prices are as follows:
